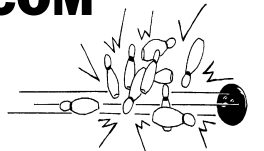

TOURNAMENT RULES

- This tournament is open to USBC members. Participants must show photo ID and current USBC card to participate or purchase a USBC membership for \$21.00.
- This tournament will be open to men and women. A team shall be two men , two women or mixed doubles. An optional side pot singles event of both scratch and/or handicap, where the scores bowled in the doubles event are taken to make a singles event score.
- Handicap shall be based on 80% of 220 . If a bowler has no verifiable average , he or she enters at 0 pins handicap. Maximum handicap is 50 pins a game for all bowlers.
- Average : Entrants will use their highest certified league average based on a minimum of 48 games of the 2008-2009 season. If no average for last year , you may use the highest certified league average of 2009-2010 season of 48 games or more.
- All bowlers are subject to re-rating in accordance with USBC rule 319,319b and 319e. The tournament director reserves the right to re-rate any bowler whose entering average does not reflect the bowlers true capability.
- Rule 319a : the 10 pin rule is waived. Bowlers who have previously participated in a tournament in this center (within the past 10 years) can be re-rated if their tournament average is 15 pins or more higher than the entering average.
- Bowlers are responsible for verifying their average, whether submitted by the bowler, the team captain or others in accordance with rule 319a-3.
- Multiple participation is allowed. You may place more than once, but only once with the same partner in the doubles event. You may participate more than once in the singles, but can cash only once in each event.
- Prize ratio - one in ten. All prize funds returned 100%.
- In case of a tie for First Place, in any event, co-champions will be declared. When ties occur, the prize money will be combined and divided equally among the tied positions.
- Bowlers shall bowl 3 games on one pair of lanes with a maximum of 3 teams per pair of lanes.
- If breakdown of 10 minutes or more occurs on a pinsetter we reserve the right to move bowler and all bowled scores to another pair of lanes that may be available. Only games that are irretrievably lost in automatic scoring device can be re-bowled.
- Entries Close August 15,2010 at 4:30pm, all pre-entries Close on July 9,2010 to allow confirmation of time and dates of participation to the team captains.
- The tournament director reserves the right to accept or reject any or all entries as he/she sees fit, all decisions are final.
- Protests and Appeals: all protests must be in writing, stating the grounds for the protest. The decision of the tournament director is final, unless a written appeal is filed with both the local association and USBC headquarters. All prize money must be withheld until the protest or appeal is resolved.
- Professional Bowlers of any classification are not eligible for this tournament.
- The Prize Fund will be paid within 30 days of the end of the tournament, unless a protest or an appeal has been filed in compliance with rule 329.The Prize Fund will be paid out within 30 days of the resolution of the protest or appeal.
- Premature termination of the tournament brought about by war, national emergency or emergency cause relating to fire, national disaster, or any other reason beyond the control of the tournament director, shall require all advertised prize money be pro-rated in accordance with the number of entrants who have bowled, up until said premature termination.
- Non-compliance with one or more of the rules, non-disclosure or misrepresentation to the tournament officials, constitutes complete disqualification for that/those entries and all prize monies of the noncomplying, nondisclosing and/or misrepresenting parties.All parties disqualified will be banned from all tournaments held at Shamrock Bowling Center, unless the tournament director reinstates them.
- Any challenge made by a participant against the tournament and/or officials, that result in any kind of legal action, that participant hereby agrees that participant will pay all reasonable fees and expenses incurred by the tournament and /or officials, should the tournament and/or officials prevail in the defense of said challenge.
- A Social Security number must be provided by the bowler for winnings of \$600.00 or more . Failure to provide a SSN, a 28% with-holding tax will be withheld prior to the issuance of prize money. This is an Internal Revenue Service requirement.
- All bowlers are entered into The Break-The-Bank, at no cost to the bowler. You must notify a tournament official before you start the last game to verify the strike frames of that game, failure to do so will disqualify you from the break-the-bank.
